### Costume Concert Sponsor

This yearly TYSA tradition is the most popular concert each year. The audience and musicians come dressed up in costumes and each orchestra plays music from movies, musicals, and more—along with some spooky favorites!

### Evergreen Music Festival Camps

Session 1 and Session 2 of the Evergreen Music Festival are unique weeklong summer camps that bring young musicians together to dig deeper into music than they ever imagined possible! This includes rehearsals, coachings with professional faculty, free public concerts, and creating unforgettable friendships and memories.

### Double Bass Workshop Sponsor

The one and only workshop in the Pacific Northwest focused purely on the study of the double bass! This workshop brings together over fifty bassists each year, with a world-class artistic faculty and incredible opportunities for rehearsals, masterclasses, and recitals.

### TYS Concert Sponsor

The Tacoma Youth Symphony is the older high school orchestra, with strings, winds, brass, and percussion. TYS students perform the most advanced orchestral repertoire, and in addition to their regular season concerts, TYS students perform at the Discover Music education concert for Tacoma-area fourth graders.

### Discover Music Education Concert

Over two thousand fourth graders from around Tacoma experience classical music for the first time! TYS students perform *Peter and the Wolf*, music from *Star Wars*, and other fun works to introduce the fourth graders to classical music and get them excited to select their first band or orchestra instrument.

### String Orchestra Festival

Over 1,200 middle school orchestra students from around the region gather in a unique non-competitive performance festival. Each group plays for one another, takes part in a large combined orchestra, works with TYSA conductors, and has the opportunity to listen to TYSA chamber musicians.

### Chamber Music Program/Concert

This special leadership training program gives principal musicians in each ensemble an opportunity to learn the art of small ensemble playing with multiple professional coachings from TYSA coaches and conductors, while working towards a free public performance.

### Symphonic Jazz Workshop Sponsor

This exciting, fun workshop explores orchestral works at the intersection of classical and jazz styles, and allows students to broaden their musical horizons, with a culminating performance in downtown Tacoma venues like the Spanish Ballroom.

### Tacoma Community Ukulele Project

Students with no prior musical experience can learn ukulele in this fun and dynamic program, which builds music skills through group classes. These classes are held in partnership with local schools, community centers, youth centers, senior living facilities, and more!

### Guest Artist Soloist Sponsor

Guest artists are world-class professional musicians who are invited to join a TYSA orchestra in a featured performance. These artists also provide community masterclasses and join TYSA for a residency at the end of a concert cycle.

### TJYS Concert Sponsor

TJYS is the younger high school orchestra, which is often students' first experience with a full orchestra (strings, winds, brass, and percussion). They rehearse and perform throughout the year, including outreach performances in the community.

### Discover Drums Sponsor

Students learn rhythm skills and try out world percussion instruments in a fun drum circle setting—no previous musical experience necessary! These community classes are offered in partnership with senior living facilities, youth centers, Metro Parks, local libraries, and more!

### Concerto Spotlight Concert Sponsor

Students of all ages independently prepare solo pieces and audition to perform in this concert, held annually in February at the Museum of Glass.

### TSS/TWP/TSP Concert Sponsor

These three orchestras are our entry-level orchestras for elementary and middle school students. These groups have an abundance of spirit, energy, and talent!

### Tacoma Young Violin Program

6- to 10-year old students meet weekly for entry-level group violin classes, where they discover the violin and prepare to join one of the TYSA orchestras!
