#### **WHAT TO BRING:**

O Instrument + Bow
O Bass Stool (if you use one)
O Rosin & Accessories
O Folding Music Stand
OLunch
O Music (will be distributed the first day of camp)
O Pencils & Eraser
O Staff Paper (can be purchased at local music store)
O Lined paper for note taking.
O Folder or small binder for staff paper and lined paper
O Tuner, metronome, mutes, etc. (whatever your instrument requires)
O Must have endpin stops or straps to protect the floors.
WHAT NOT TO BRING:
O Cell Phones (may be kept on student but must be turned off during the festival)
O Hand-held video games
O IPods or like equipment
O Gum
O Anything that will distract you, your fellow campers, or the conductor.
